



## **TECHNICAL NOTE**

### **CLEANING CONCRETE SURFACES WITH DEEP CLEAN 250 or 500**

Concrete surfaces rapidly collect dirt, oil and grease in addition to efflorescence that exudes from the surface under certain conditions.

As the concrete ages and carbonates the alkalinity of the surface becomes lower leading to the growth of mould and algae.

The concrete can easily be cleaned of all contaminants using either Deep Clean 250, or for heavy grease oil and dirt, Deep Clean 500.

Deep Clean is also especially useful for cleaning factory or kitchen floors, car parks or garage forecourts etc.

## **APPLICATION**

1. Clean any loose dirt and materials so as to present a bare surface ready for cleaning.
2. Apply Deep Clean (undiluted) to the surface to be cleaned. Do not pre-wet the surface.
3. Brush the Deep Clean into the surface with a stiff brush.
4. Allow the Deep Clean to work on the surface for about 30 minutes.
5. Ensure the surface is not being damaged by the Deep Clean, if so wash off immediately.
6. After 30 minutes rinse the surface off with clean water.
