USE OF DEEP PENETRATING SEALER FOR ANTI-DUSTING OF CONCRETE SURFACES

Most concrete surfaces experience dusting after the construction. The dusting is mainly due to insufficient moist curing of the surface, which results in incomplete hydration of the Portland cement in the concrete.

The dusting of the surface can be eliminated by hardening and sealing it with the application of two coats of Deep Penetrating Sealer.

APPLICATION

1. Make sure the concrete surface to be treated is clean and free from oil and grease.
2. If necessary clean the concrete surface with Deep Clean 250.
3. Pre-wet the concrete cleaned surface, and apply two coats of DPS.
4. The second coat of DPS should be applied about 24 hours after the first application. For highly absorbent surfaces additional coats may be necessary. Test a small area by spraying with DPS. If it is still absorbing material into the surface then an extra coat may be required.

However two coats are normally sufficient.
